Rift-cut White Oak features a long, straight grain pattern with a uniform, even appearance.

Grain patterns with more movement are found in our Bespoke White Oak cabinets and can include quartersawn grain with visible medullary rays and flecking.

A range of finishes has been carefully chosen to highlight the characteristic grain of our white oak cabinetry.

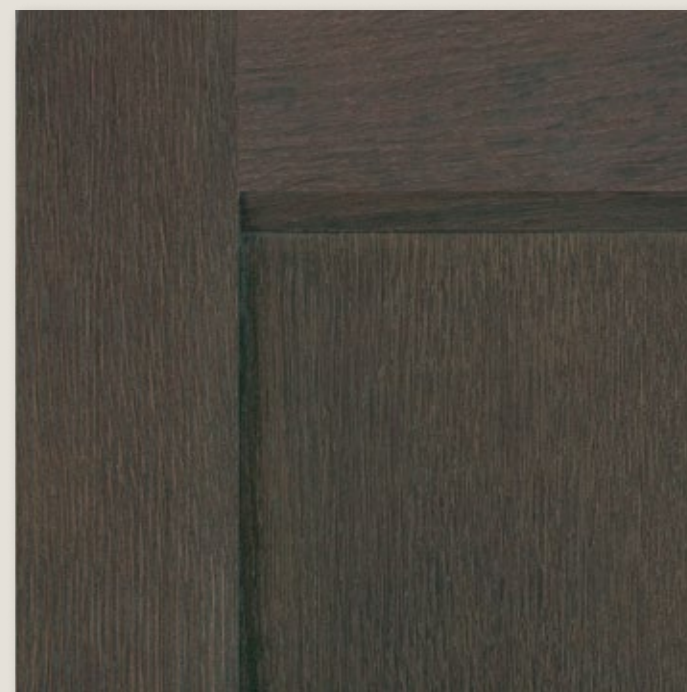

White Oak finishes are offered with three levels of sheen: Standard, Satin and Super Matte.

- **Standard finish** has a cured target sheen of 34, with 100 being a mirror finish and zero having no gloss.
- **Satin finish** has a slightly softer look than our Standard finish, with a cured target sheen of 17.
- **Super Matte finish** creates a furniture look with an eggshell finish with virtually zero gloss.
